Tucked away deep in the Somerset countryside a small 16th century Inn has undergone a remarkable transformation over the past few months and gained a "glittering prize" in the process!

The Farmers Inn at West Hatch near Taunton has now been refurbished to such a high standard that the five-bedroom Inn has been awarded five diamonds under the national grading standards set jointly by Visit Britain, the AA and the RAC. Only 19 hotels and guesthouses throughout Somerset have been awarded the full five diamonds, signifying an "excellent overall level of quality".

Complimenting the individually-designed rooms, some with sitting areas, one even with its own patio, is a comprehensive restaurant menu, featuring a wide range of locally sourced ingredients, along with an extensive and balanced wine list and cask ale on tap. The small touches, such as home made marmalade on the breakfast table, are what makes a stay at the Farmers Inn an unforgettable experience.

"It's been a lot of hard work, and at times we started to doubt that we would ever achieve our vision" said co-owner Debbie Lush, who said goodbye to her career as an artist in London three years ago after seeing and falling in love with the ancient hostelry. "But when we look at the Inn now we know it was worth it. Being awarded the five diamonds was a tremendous honour and a culmination of our efforts to make the Farmers Inn a very special place to stay".

The Inn, which is surrounded by the Somerset Levels and enjoys extensive views over the countryside, was recently featured on Channel 4's 'Britain's Best Breaks' and a read through the Visitor's Guest Book will confirm that many visitors, having discovered such a jewel in the countryside, intend to return as soon as possible.

This year, a pre-Christmas menu is soon to be launched, along with details of extra-special evening Christmas parties, either in the restaurant or the Inn's function room, with the option of staying overnight. For daytime meals, the new lunchtime menu offers a wealth of high quality choices, and many seasonably available foods can be found in the bar snack menu.
